

BATH SUNDAY MARKET VENDORS AGREEMENT

Welcome to the Bath Sunday Market!

- The market season runs from May 7 to October 15, 2023 in Loyalist Park on Main Street in Bath, Ontario.
- Hours of operation are 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Vendors should arrive earlier to set up and be ready for business by 10:00.
- Vendors are responsible for obtaining and maintaining their own liability insurance. Vendors can either source their own insurance or purchase online through the OHA <https://gardenontario.org/new-vendors-insurance-from-duuo/>.
- Vendors are encouraged to not set up or take down their stalls during market business hours.
- Vendors are expected to provide their own tables and canopies.
- Any individual advertising signs are to be displayed outside the vendor's stall, not along Hwy 33. The BGC puts up signage along Hwy 33 for all market participants.
- Regular and returning vendors have priority to set up in the same spot throughout the season.
- The market manager will have a map of the assigned sites.
- The market manager has the right to ask a vendor to change location during the season.
- No political activity is permitted at the market.
- Non-profit community-based groups may attend to sell items for fundraising. The fee for this activity may be waived.
- The weekly vendor fee is \$15.00 and is payable after 10:00. Exact payment in cash is requested as change may not always be available.
- Photographs of the market space and stalls may be taken and displayed for market publicity purposes on the BGC website, FaceBook site and on market promotional literature, posters, flyers; these images bear no identification of individuals.
